



Sustainable European Office Construction 2010

Student Competition

for integrated lifecycle design of a Sustainable Office Concept

In the context of the COST Action C25 - Sustainability of Constructions: Integrated Approach to Life-time Structural Engineering, a competition among students is launched for the design of an Office Building according to the aims of Sustainable Construction.

This competition is open to students of all European countries as well as other COST countries. Applications may be submitted either by individuals or by teams of up to 4 students. All members of the team must provide proof that they were students (Bachelor, Master, Doctorate) at the time the work for the competition was conducted.

The objective is a design of an office building in defined location and limited size. This competition will focus on material and zero-energy concepts. The analysis of the building must follow a Life Cycle approach and for the lifecycle analyses is considering 50 years for the building.

The winner proposals will be presented in the COST C25 Meeting in Naples on April 2009 by all the authors team.

First prize: 1.000 € for the team and all the authors invited in the meeting (all the expenses, including travel and hotel costs will be paid by the COST Office), **second prize:** 600 € for the team, **third prize:** 400 € for the team.
